

Roof drainage

The gutter is a component that collects the rainwater running off the roof surface and drains it off the roof via a downpipe to prevent waterlogging. The individual gutters are connected by means of gutter connectors, the fastening with gutter supports/holders - also known as gutter irons. Channel end pieces or channel bases ensure a professional finish.

If you would like to break new ground in terms of appearance, choose an alternative to the classic semi-circular channel

a box-shaped gutter. This sets an attractive accent on the building - the functionality corresponds to that of a semi-circular channel. The corresponding accessories are of course also available for the connection, attachment and termination.
